51.3 Matters for debate

51.3.1 To discuss purchase of 3 cast metal heritage finger signs

Two quotations emailed to Councillors from Finger Post Sign and Leander Architectural were discussed and it was unanimously agreed by Councillors to order the signs from Leander Architectural. It was also unanimously agreed to send payment to Leander Architectural so that work can begin on the signs

Our District Councillors have agreed to payment of £750 each from their locality budgets. Cllr Peat is providing final information to East Suffolk so that the monies can be released. He is waiting for the planners to confirm that no planning permission will be required. Cllr Peat advised that the parish council will need a street furniture licence the fee for which Suffolk County Council has agreed to waive. Also Suffolk County Council has agreed that if any of the new signs are damaged in the future they will replace with standard fingerpost signs if the Parish Council were unable to replace them with heritage signs. Cllr Gourlay thanked Alan for all his work on this.

Clerk to call Suffolk County Councillor Elaine Bryant to discuss a possible contribution towards installation of the signs.

51.3.2 To discuss installation of 3 cast metal heritage finger signs

There are two quotations for installation of the signs - from Holmes Civils Ltd for £1,896.00 and from Highway Assurance of Barham for £2,540.43. It was agreed unanimously that the council would appoint Holmes to install the signs.
